ORDINANCE NUMBER <u>6-7-20</u>2/

- 1. The Town of Shiloh, acting through its Mayor, Brad Graben, and Council, adopts this Ordinance at a regular meeting of the Town Council held on which this Ordinance was considered, adopted by the unanimous vote of all members of the Council.
- 2. It is found and determined by the Council that the population of Shiloh is less than 2,000. Further, that there is no newspaper published within the Town Limits.
- 3. This ordinance pertains to the distribution of public water to the residents, businesses and commercial establishments within the Town Limits by the WATERWORKS, SEWER and GAS BOARD OF THE TOWN OF SECTION, whose mailing address is P.O. Box 1159, Rainsville, Alabama 35986.

Prior to the incorporation of the Town of Shiloh, the Waterworks Board of the Town of Section (The Board) was providing water service to the residences, businesses and commercial establishments located with the area now within the corporate limits of Shiloh. The Board installed its water lines within such area in the year 1961 and commenced providing water to those residing within the Town Limits before the Town was incorporated. Since the incorporation of the Town, the Board has continued to serve the residents located within the Town Limits without the benefit of a written ordinance.

4. As the Board continues to make improvements in its water distribution system for the benefit of its customers, including those water customers within the Town Limits of Shiloh, it is desirable for the Town to provide an ordinance for the Board commemorating past water service to its residents, businesses and commercial establishments.

5. Based on the foregoing findings and recitals, the Town Council of the Town of Shiloh does hereby grant unto the Waterworks, Sewer and Gas Board of the Town of Section (The Board) a franchise to continue to operate a water distribution system in accordance with the terms hereof.

The Board may continue to install, repair, renew, relay and extend such pipes, poles, water lines, mains, conductors, fixtures and related appurtenances and to make all excavations necessary therefor.

- 6. The Board shall continue to be responsible for repairing, restoring the surface of all excavation to the public streets, alleys or highways to substantially the same condition as before the work was done within a reasonable time and will save the Town harmless from any liability arising out of the change of condition of any street, alley or highway caused by the Board.
- 7. The rights, privileges, authorities granted hereby shall continue in force and effect until the Board or its successor shall be dissolved.
- 8. The terms of this Ordinance shall be binding upon the Town, its successors and assigns as well as the Board, its successors and assigns.
- 9. The Council elects not to publish this Ordinance but upon its adoption for a copy of the same to be posted in three public places within the Town Limits, one being the office of the Mayor. (Section 11-45-8(b), Code of Alabama 1975 as amended).
